NOTICE



To measure flow rate: Place a container under the faucet, and turn on the cold water at full blast for exactly 10 seconds.. Use a measuring cup to measure the water you collected, convert to gallons, and multiply by 6.

The average flow rate of U.S. faucets is between 1.0 and 2.2 gpm (gallons per minute). If your faucet has a higher flow rate, consider installing a low-flow faucet to reduce water consumption.

CHEMICAL:	WASH PROCEDURE:

Different chemicals require different levels of diligence to clean them off of laboratory equipment. Consider taking this into account to conserve water.
